

## G.A.M.A. Point System Revised for 2012

To reward club members for participating in club activities the Executive Committee has increased the number of activities by which members may accumulate points. The new point system as presented below will take effect in 2012. The points will continue to be used to bid on hobby items at our year-end auction. An attendance sheet will be used at each activity to keep track of POINTS and it is the member's responsibility to see that his or her name is on the attendance sheet. Members points cannot be combined with other member's points and all points are eliminated at the end of each year.

The monthly door prizes and year-end auction will be funded solely by a portion of membership dues. That portion of the dues remaining after all operating expenses have been paid will be used for these activities. No money will be taken from our reserve fund or from reserve fund activities such as the Swap Meet or fees received at contests.

### Points breakdown as follows.

Flying field maintenance work	10 points
Working at a club Fun-Fly	10 points
Participating in a club Fun-Fly	10 points
Working at a club Contest	10 points
Participating in a club contest	10 points
Working at club Swap Meet (set up)	15 points **
Working at club Swap Meet (all day)	25 points **
Working Swap Meet kitchen (all day)	50 points
Swap Meet Kitchen Manager.	150 points
Bring a New Member into the Club	25 points
Working on a standing committee	Determined by committee Chairman
Chairman of standing committee	Determined by the Executive Committee
Web master	100 points

\* 5 points for a show-&-tell of a bare bones kit or scratch built model. Points for the same model finished ready to fly will be 10 points. All other show-&-tell will receive 5 points

\*\*15 points for set-up and 15 points for tear down, which are on separate days. 25 points for all day work, each day. Therefore, if someone shows up to set-up tables and chairs, that person gets 15 points. If he/she shows up to put stuff away, another 15 points. For someone who stays all day and works the entry tables, etc. 25 points for each day. This way a person that helps set-up, tear down, and works the two days will get 80 points. Also for working all day in the kitchen a person will receive 50 points and 100 points for both days.

\*\*\* If there are more than 3 Chili cook volunteers, names will be drawn from a hat. There will be NO points added or subtracted for Good or Bad Chili.
